

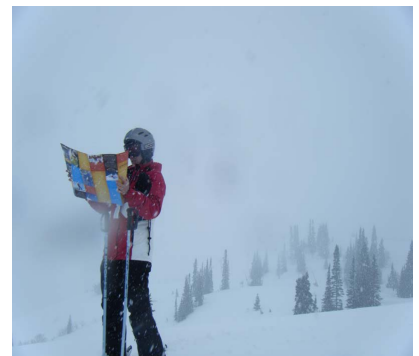

Dr. Cathy Callow-Heusser, Education Specialist, with the Utah State Board of Education will be speaking to parents and educators about *"Mindsets, Multiple Strategies, and Making Meaning: The Importance of Why"* as it relates to helping children succeed in mathematics.



Catherine Callow-Heusser received her doctorate in Educational Research and Evaluation from Utah State University, where she worked 20 of the past 30 years as an instructor, instructional designer and researcher/evaluator of programs serving struggling students and students with learning disabilities. Dr. Callow-Heusser worked for many years with Dr. Alan Hofmeister at the Center for Persons with Disabilities at USU and helped develop the Reading for All Learners books. Dr. Callow-Heusser served as the Director of Developmental Mathematics at USU from 2013-2015. She has taught mathematics and statistics at the middle school, high school, and college levels, and she continues to teach as an adjunct instructor at Salt Lake Community College. She joined the Utah State Board of Education as an Education Specialist in 2015, working on both the Utah Multi-Tiered System of Supports and State Systemic Improvement Plan projects.
