

Entitled Celebrate Trade, the elegant evening gala raises funds for the tax-exempt Oregon Consular Corps Scholarship Fund which provides scholarships to students at four Oregon universities. These funds allow Oregon's next generation of leaders to study abroad, gain international experience and expand their own cultural competence as they prepare to enter an increasingly global workplace.

The gala also recognizes the significant contribution Oregon's traded-sector companies make to our region's economic vitality and quality of life. International business awards are provided in five categories. Also, the consular corps selects an additional organization or individual to recognize.











Sponsorship dollars raised through the Celebrate Trade event provide two scholarships of \$2,500 each year to students from Lewis & Clark College, Portland State University, Oregon State University and University of Oregon.

With 94 percent of the world's consumers living outside of the United States, the next generation of business and community leaders will increasingly need international relations and language skills, cultural awareness and an ability to grasp the opportunities and challenges of a global economy.

In addition, it is important that we recognize Oregon businesses that are today leveraging the strengths of Oregon's trade based economy and expanding their markets around the globe. Consider these facts:

- International trade supports more than 484,000 Oregon jobs.
- \$20 billion of goods were exported from Oregon in 2015.
- Oregon exports represent 10 percent of the state's GDP over the last decade.
- 1 in 4 manufacturing jobs in Oregon are export related.
- Customers in 203 countries and territories buy Oregon made goods and services.

More than 6,000 Oregon businesses, large and small, sell their products internationally. At this event we recognize several of them and shine the spotlight on their international successes as inspiration to others who may have global ambitions.


