## SENIOR EXAM SCHEDULE: May 2018

- Students are expected to take their exams on assigned days and must remain in the testing area until the test period has ended.
- Students are required to be in attendance during exam times only.

- Students who are too ill to write a scheduled exam must have a written statement from a doctor to have an exam rescheduled.
- Students tardy to school will pay a \$50 re-schedule fee.
- All semester exams are final. The semester mark will be determined by a combination of 1st quarter (40%), 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter (40%) and midterm exam (20%).
- Mid-term and final exams must be designed to be 1.25 hour exams for the average student and at least one written component should be included on the exam.
