## **Voluntary Revocation**

I (We), as Licensee(s) of the above named premises have met with a representative of the office of the Mayor of the City of Chicago, who has advised me (us) of my (our) right to a public hearing before the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection/Local Liquor Control Commission of the City of Chicago relative to an incident(s) which occurred on or about the licensed premises on 1/21/16 (failure to open safe, outdated merchandise); 3 tobacco violations within 2 years.

I (We) have thoroughly discussed the incident(s) and have been afforded the opportunity to present any or all facts concerning the incident(s), either orally or by way of affidavit.

I (We) hereby elect to waive my (our) right to a formal hearing and voluntarily agree to have my (our) license Revoked (licensee only not premises). I (We) agree to voluntarily revoke and surrender the licenses for the location listed above to the custody of the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection on or before 9/30/16.

I (We) further understand that the voluntary fine and revocation of this license is to be construed as a settlement or disposition related to the current charges pending with the Department of Business Affairs & Consumer Protection under Case Numbers 16 NR 95, 16 NR 171. It is further agreed between the parties that the licensee(s) shall not appeal this voluntary revocation at any time in the future.

This agreed resolution of the violation(s) is made with express understanding that this revocation shall be made a permanent record of the licensee's disciplinary history and may be introduced as evidence of aggravation in conjunction with other charges of misconduct in any future proceeding.
