**Young Writers Workshop, 9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m., \$75/new student, \$65/returning student and sibling**

This workshop is for interested and motivated writers in grades 5-12. Workshops are run by NVWP Teacher Consultants. Class size is small, with an average of 12 students. Students are assigned to 3 workshop sessions: 2 of their choice and 1 reading/writing group. Students select their workshop sessions from this list:

Parents are invited to a discussion on supporting student writers and writing as a family.

**Family Writers Workshop, 2:00 p.m.-3:30 p.m., \$25/family (Nov. 11 ONLY)**

Young Writers, parents, and siblings (kindergarten and up) will learn about how to create write nights, preserve writing, and have fun with keeping the writing going from week to week.
