Author of *The World Peace Diet* and accomplished musician, Dr. Tuttle's work focuses on compassion, creativity, and intuition.



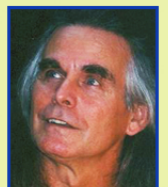
Robyn Finseth
