



Dr. Henry Rosenberg's Biography:

Dr. Henry Rosenberg is Director of Medical Education and Clinical Research, at Saint Barnabas Medical Center, Livingston New Jersey. He assumed this position in 2002. Prior to 2002 Dr Rosenberg's career was focused on academic anesthesiology. He was program director for two training programs and served as Chairman of the Department of Anesthesiology at Hahnemann University for over 15 years. He also was a senior examiner for the American Board of Anesthesiology. In his current position, he is responsible for the administrative management of nine residency programs comprising 160 residents as well as medical student programs and CME activities based at the Medical Center. He holds the rank of Clinical Professor of Anesthesiology at Rutgers/New Jersey Medical School.

Dr. Rosenberg has been a member of the editorial boards of several anesthesiology journals. He has published over 140 manuscripts in peer reviewed medical journals. He is the President of the Malignant Hyperthermia Association of the US, a not for profit patient advocacy organization which he helped create in 1981. In 2007 an endowed lectureship in his name was established at Hahnemann University.

Dr. Rosenberg is a well known lecturer, author and investigator in anesthesia related topics. His special interests are in the Malignant Hyperthermia Syndrome, medical history and medical education.
