Dr. Shawn Cannon is the Chief Academic Officer at Southampton Hospital. He started his medical studies at NYIT-College of Osteopathic Medicine, in an accelerated program. He earned his B.S and D.O. degrees in seven years. From there he studied medicine at the University Hospital for the Albert Einstein College of Medicine, Montefiore Medical Center in the City of New York., where he served as chief resident in the Department of Social Internal Medicine. He is a board certified osteopathic internist with sub-specialty boards in Hospice and Palliative Medicine. He is also and active member of the American Osteopathic Association of Addiction Medicine and the American Society of Addiction Medicine. He founded the Residency Program in Social Medicine at Southmpton to ensure medial students and residents were being educated in the fields of medicine that are acutely affecting citizens of the United States. Pain Management, Addiction Medicine and Palliative Care are often given minimal attention in U.S. medical schools. Although opiate addiction is the number one cause of death in young Americans, it still has no requirement in general medical training programs in the United States. Change starts here, at Southampton Hospital.
