Seeking to Save the Lost

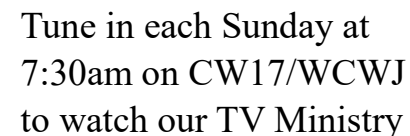

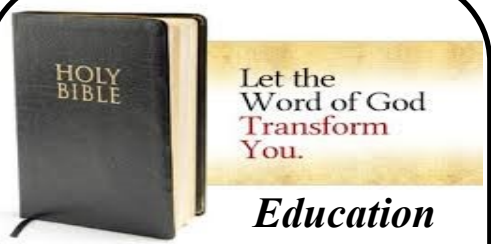


Meet Your Health Ministry
