Christians

"And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch" (Acts 11:26). What comes into your mind when you hear the word "Christian?" It often means one thing to one person and something entirely different to someone else. In today's society there are hyphenated "Christians" depending upon what particular religious body you happen to claim. **The bible knows no such thing.** Again, today the name is applied to all religious people who claim to follow the teachings of Christ. But some who claim to follow His teachings are picking and choosing which they want to follow and which are "alright" to ignore.

Used only three times in the Bible (Acts 11:26, 26:28, 1 Pet. 4:16), the word "Christian" speaks to a close relationship with Christ our Lord". Wearing the name Christian places us into the family of God where we live and work together with one heart and one soul. It is truly a most excellent, noble and majestic name by which to be known. Being a Christian involves a host of things, a few of which are: following God's instructions (Matt. 7:21, John 14:15), studying God's word (II Tim. 2:15; Acts 17:11), being a light to the world (Matt. 5:16), being narrow (Matt. 7:13-16). Let's do more than say we are Christians, let's be Christians!
