More Than Conquerors

Rom. 8:37, "Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us." **Rom. 8:31-39** is an encouraging passage that offers us comfort as we cope with various issues of life.

We must never be deluded into thinking that being a child of God is an easy life. It is not always easy to obey the Lord's plan for being saved when all around us there are those who are presenting easy ways. Zone/Cell Leaders, please help the Administrative Office keep up with our sick, shut-in and bereaved members by notifying us of those members when you become aware.




