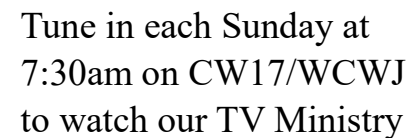
From the Minister's Office...

What Is Love?

With Valentine's Day, a man made celebration, just around the corner, let's talk about the definition of love. Everyone seems to believe that love is a good thing. However, **not all agree on the definition of love.** Is love that warm touchy-feely feeling a person has when he is with a familiar person? **According to the Bible, love is caring in action. Love isn't what we feel, but what we do.**

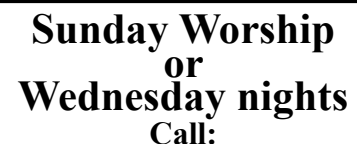
The Greek language (the language of the New Testament) uses two different words to describe and define love. The most commonly used Greek word translated "**love**" in the New Testament is "**agape.**" This love is represented by God's love for us. It is a non-partial, sacrificial love probably best exemplified by God's provision for our rebellion (**John 3:16**). This kind of love is extended through the spirit and gives expecting nothing in return. It is best described in **I Corinthians 13:1-13**. In contrast, our love is usually conditional and based upon how others behave toward us. The Greek word "**phileo**" defines this kind of love, often translated "**brotherly love.**" The Christian life should not be restricted to just moral excellence, but, above all else, should include both phileo and agape love (**2 Pet. 1:5-7**). 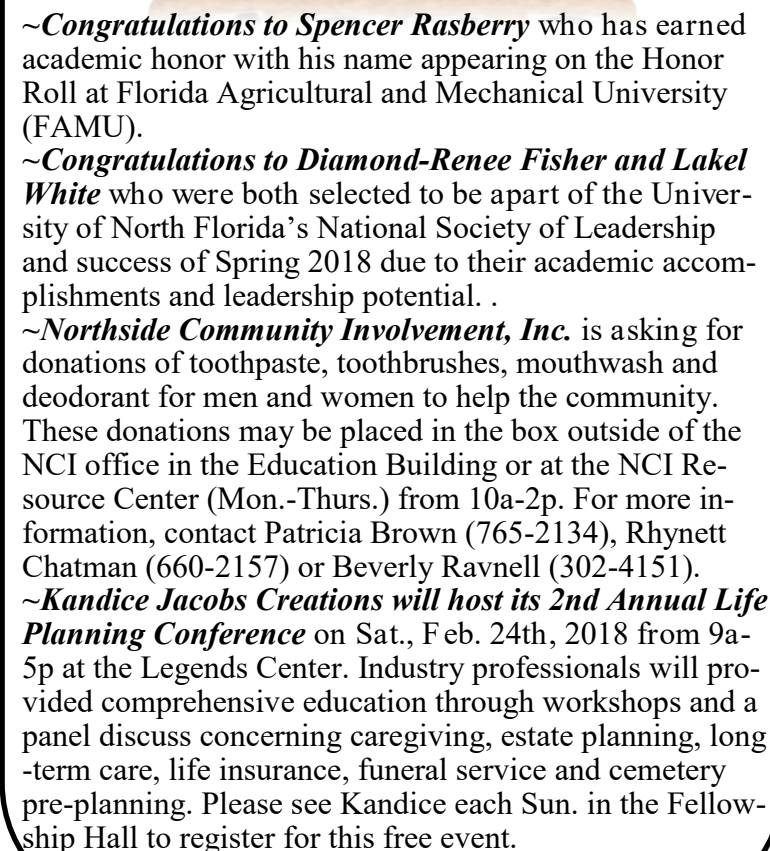
