

SunCoast Cathedral MCC – Upcoming Board of Director Openings

At our next Annual Meeting, scheduled for January 20, 2018, all active voting members will have an opportunity to vote for four Board members (three terms are ending and one is vacant). We will be accepting nominations from Sunday, November 26 through Sunday, December 17.

Interested candidates must be spiritually mature, have been active voting members in good standing of this church for at least one year and need to have shown leadership abilities in the congregation. Candidates must demonstrate evidence of stewardship in tithes, talents and time and attendance with participation at worship and other church related activities. Candidates must exhibit a strong sense of commitment to confidentiality and sign the appropriate risk management documents. We are seeking individuals who have experience in at least one of the following: building and grounds, contract management, financial and business acumen, development, previous board experience, and strategic planning. The individual must be able to work with others collaboratively, have a working knowledge of financial statements, demonstrate respect for others, have a sense of responsibility for making things happen and a vision to see beyond today. Lastly, candidates must not be in a covenant type relationship with someone already serving on the board of directors.

We invite interested individuals to pray about this potential call and complete an application. The application and instructions can be found in Volunteer Office. Applicants who meet the requirements and have submitted completed packages on or before December 17, 2017, will be invited to an interview in early January with our Nominating Team, which is composed of the Pastors, a Board member and Deacon. Applicants who successfully make it through this down-select process will be presented to the congregation for vote at the January 20, Annual Meeting.
