CLE presentations will take place on the bus as we drive to each location.

The itinerary is as follows (times may slightly vary):

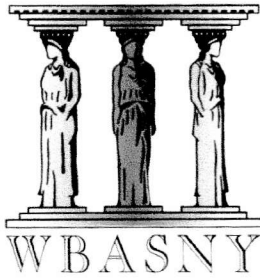
10:00: meet at Orange County Courthouse

The cost is \$85.00 per person and includes the two CLE credits, tastings and bus transportation. Price is \$65.00 per person if attendee does not want CLE credit. Payment must be in advance.
