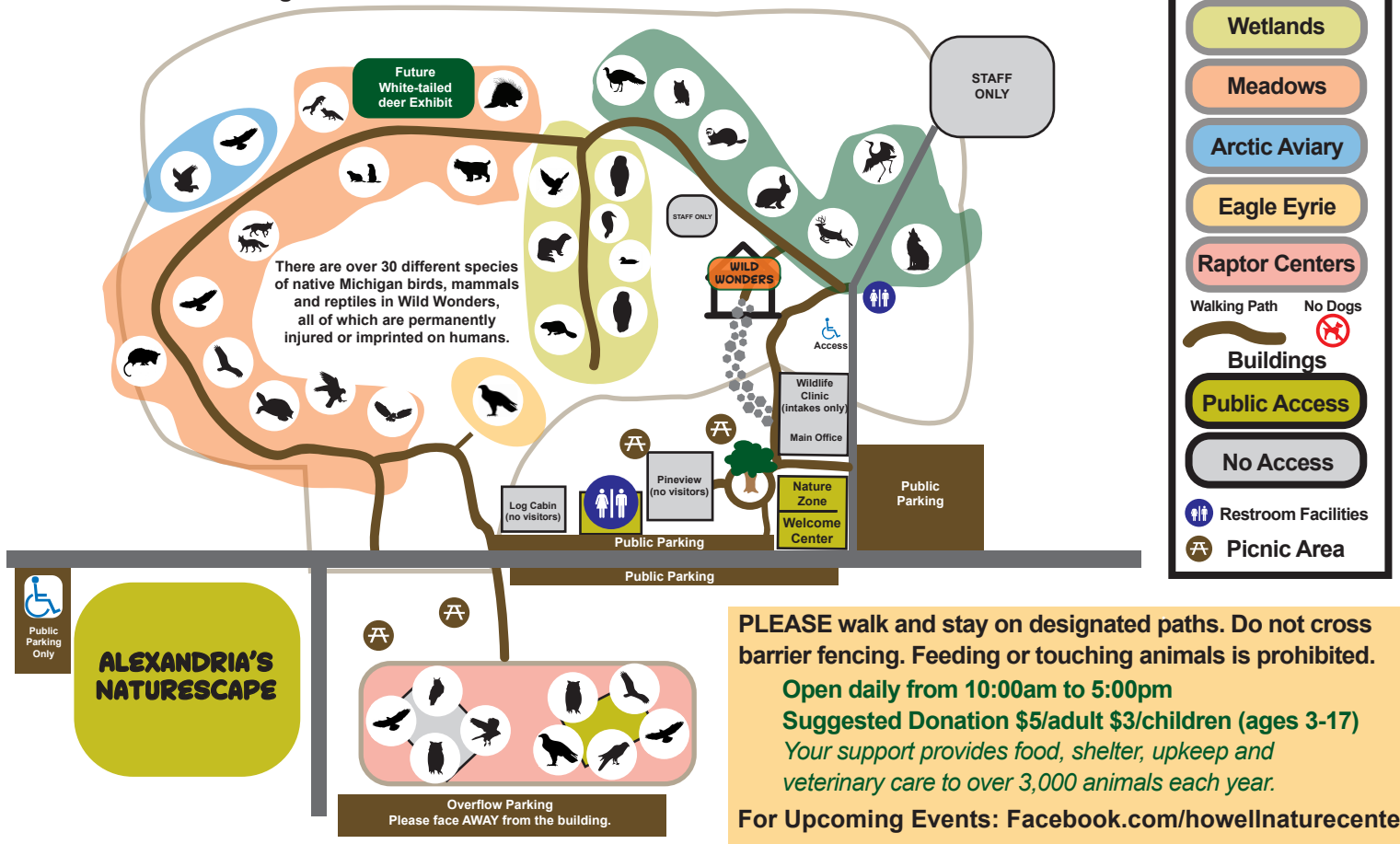


WILD WONDERS WILDLIFE PARK and Public Day Use Areas



Why do we now need a visitor pass to enter the Naturescape and Wild Wonders?

For over 13 years, the Howell Nature Center has had a suggested donation to use our Day Use facilities. Some people have been very generous, some have not. Due to increasing costs of maintaining our popular facilities and caring for the parks animals, we must now request this donation.

Every dollar we do not receive to maintain our Day Use area means possible funds being diverted from our Wildlife Rehabilitation Program - a vital and FREE community service which provides veterinary care to injured local wildlife.
