The Miracle League of Milwaukee is an organized baseball league for children, ages 4-19, with cognitive and/or physical disabilities. Special-needs kids dress in uniforms, make plays in the field and round the bases, just like their peers in standard little leagues.

Games are played on Tuesday and Thursday nights at the Northwest YMCA on the Werner Family Foundation Field, a custom-designed field, that features a cushioned, rubberized, completely flat surface to prevent injuries and allow access for the visually impaired and those in wheelchairs. All areas of the field, including the dugouts and restrooms, are universally accessible.

Teams are assigned prior to the start of the season. All players will be partnered with a volunteer "Buddy" to assist and protect them during games. Miracle League believes every child deserves the opportunity to play baseball.
