On November 7, 2014, the FRA published a final rule for training requirements for all railroad employees and contractors who perform safety-related work. The Final Rule requires railroad employees and contractors who perform safety-related work to be trained and qualified to comply with any relevant federal railroad safety laws, regulations, and orders. The rule represents the first time that railroad contractors will be directly regulated by the FRA.

The requirements include minimum training standards for each type of safety-related railroad employee, with the FRA reviewing and approving each employer's training program to determine that each employee will be qualified to measurable standards. The rule also calls for greater use of structured on-the-job and interactive training.

There will be a presentation and time for Q&A afterwards.
