Transforming School Mental Health Services

Building a Comprehensive Mental Health System for School-based practitioners with Dr. Beth Doll, Interim Dean and Professor at the University of Nebraska Lincoln

Description This workshop will focus on transforming school mental health services through the changing focus of intervention on health and psychological wellness as opposed to disturbance; examining the prevalence and incidence of mental disorders and of the psychosocial risk factors that predict the emergence of psychological disturbance; and weaving population based with individual and small group interventions promoting mental health.



Who should attend? This workshop is appropriate for all school personnel who need to understand how the comprehensive school based mental health systems are organized and function. This can include but is not limited to school psychologists, school counselors, administrators, teachers, other pupil services personnel, security officers, front office staff, transportation directors, and before and after school activities coordinators.

Instructional format: Lecture

By the end of the presentation, participants will be able to

1. Understand how to profile the psychological wellness and distress in their school or community
2. Know how to use existing supports and infrastructure to promote mental health within the school enrollment
3. Be able to use classroom surveys to describe some particular sources of stress or distress within a classroom
4. Be able to scan the physical environment of a school to identify trouble spots and the places where children interact successfully
5. And map the community's systems of supports and gaps in support that can be alleviated with careful planning
