

Winter Relief is a program run by Arundel House of Hope, which provides emergency temporary shelter to homeless men and women in Anne Arundel County during the coldest months of the year. Participating churches (and one synagogue, Temple Beth Shalom) take turns hosting homeless guests for one week at a time. Arundel House of Hope is a nonprofit, ecumenical organization based in Glen Bernie which has been providing Winter Relief and other housing programs to the poor and homeless since 1992.
