Jennifer Rudick Zunikoff is a Jewish storyteller, poet, educator, facilitator, and coach.

She travels to synagogues, schools, and conferences, performing stories from the Torah, Midrash and Jewish folklore. Jennifer blends tradition with imagination. She trains teachers and students to creatively tell Jewish stories.

She is the founder and director of The Golden Door: Storytelling for Social Justice, bringing speakers to Baltimore City schools to share personal stories of social justice. Jennifer serves as an Imagining Justice in Baltimore community leader for the Institute for Islamic Jewish and Christian Studies.

Jennifer was named a 2016 Baltimore Social Innovator by the Warnock Foundation.

Her CD, *The Growing Season*, comprised of her original stories, was commissioned by the Macks Center for Jewish Education in Baltimore.
