Meet the Gratz College Board of Governors: David Gordon

Living in the Philadelphia area for about 35 years, Gordon has been a part of the Philadelphia Jewish community both personally and professionally for decades. As general manager of Roosevelt Memorial Park, he has had the opportunity to observe and reflect on the many changes that have taken place within this community over the years. In his business, he has witnessed the tension between holding on to tradition and adapting to a radically changing world.
