



Immerse: Beginnings

Journey with us starting February 4!

Join us in reading *Immerse:*

Beginnings, a new and unique journey through the first five books of the Bible: Genesis through Deuteronomy. (*Immerse* is similar our journey through the *New Testament* during the Community Bible Experience last winter.)

The text is arranged in a beautiful single-column setting with chapters, verses, section headings, and footnotes removed, and with the content of each book displayed according to its literary genre. It's a version that helps readers get swept up in the story together so they can be transformed together.

Join the conversation in small groups!

Enhance the *Immerse: Beginnings* experience with simple conversations in new or existing small groups that meet once a week. to understand in context and experience in community. These book club-style conversations use just four easy questions:

1. What stood out to you this week?
2. Was there anything confusing or troubling?
3. Did anything make you think differently about God?
4. How might this change the way we live?

You can also form your own discussion group or just read along and ponder these questions on your own. Start and end dates might differ depending on which reading plan your group follows: 8-week or 16-week reading plans are available.

Regular Bible Engagement. Whether you choose *Immerse:Beginnings* or a different resource, we encourage everyone to continue deep, daily engagement with the Word of God – the best discipleship tool there is!
