How to Apply

- Must be a teacher for the upcoming school year in a public, private or post-secondary establishment
- Must be used for classroom expenses not covered by your budget
- Applicants must complete an essay on one of the following topics or a combination:
 1. How can I teach my students about money
 2. Why are money lessons important to students today
 3. Why my students would benefit from this scholarship
 4. How I plan to use this money
 5. My favorite money memory
- Essays must include the following, if missing any information you will not be considered:
 - Cover letter that includes:
 - Name
 - Contact Information (phone, address and email)
 - Name of school employed at (if undecided, please note)
 - Page numbers
 - Header on each page with only your initials (for anonymous judging)
 - Double Spaced
 - Size 11 font
 - Times New Roman Font
 - Include 500-1000 words
- Essays must be submitted by March 31st at 5:00pm CST for consideration and can be submitted one of the following ways:
