We hope to have that role filled in the summer as early as possible. Her presence will provide much needed continuity amidst these changes especially on our summer trips and mission outreach.

The downside to this change is that Nikki Greytock will be slowly phasing off of our staff. She has agreed to support the student ministry as long as she can, most likely through the summer months. As most of you have experienced, Nikki is a phenomenal administrator and we will greatly miss her organizational skills in addition to her kind and generous spirit.

Curt Solomon's is consistently spending more time in Wilmington with the church plant there and his last day on staff will be June 30. Please continue to pray for the Solomons as they prepare for their move to the Port City.

We are in the process of hiring a Church Planting pastor who will be our third pastoral presence on staff. We have three serious candidates and hope to have one or two visit our church in the coming months.
