Since the election, many across the Commonwealth have been worried and anxious. Now they are ready for action. Attorney General Maura Healey has said that she is willing to work with President Trump and the Republican Congress when they are acting in the best interests of the people of Massachusetts. Already Maura has intervened in a suit against the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau, defended the Obama administration's decision to shut-down the national accrediting agency behind predatory for-profit schools, and protected vital emissions standards for heavy vehicles passing through our communities. Within days of the immigration ban, she was one of the first AG's to file suit against the Trump administration.
