



FAQ FOR PARENTS REGARDING SCHOOL CLOSURES

Will childcare be available?

No. School closures would include all services at that school, including before- and after-school programming, clubs and activities. There are limited exceptions. Please speak with your principal.

Will meals be provided?

Meals will be provided for students at designated school locations. Detailed information will be emailed to families and posted on susd.org.

Do I need to call in my child's absence?

No. You are not required to call a child out when schools are closed.

What is the impact on graduation?

Graduation would be held as scheduled. Diplomas would be issued when all requirements, such as course completion and attendance, are met.

What is the impact on prom?

If there is adequate supervision from parents and other chaperones, proms would be held as planned.

Will athletics continue?

The District's intent is for High School Athletics to continue as scheduled, including bus transportation, but other district-run extracurricular programming may be suspended. (No Middle School sports)

Will field trips go on as scheduled?

Daily field trips dependent on SUSD transportation will be rescheduled. Overnight field trips are being addressed on a case-by-case basis. Please speak with your principal.

What transportation will be available?

There will be no bus service to closed campuses. Transportation will still be provided to students enrolled in off-campus special programs, such as EVIT and ACES.

How will testing be impacted?

Desert Mountain is prepared to administer IB tests on schedule, regardless of school status. AP tests are not set to begin until May 7 and will be addressed at a future date, if necessary. AZ Merit testing will be complete before Thursday.

If school is closed for more than one day, how will I receive communication?

Schools will be closed for the duration of the walkout. SUSD will provide daily communication and will alert parents immediately about plans to reopen schools.
