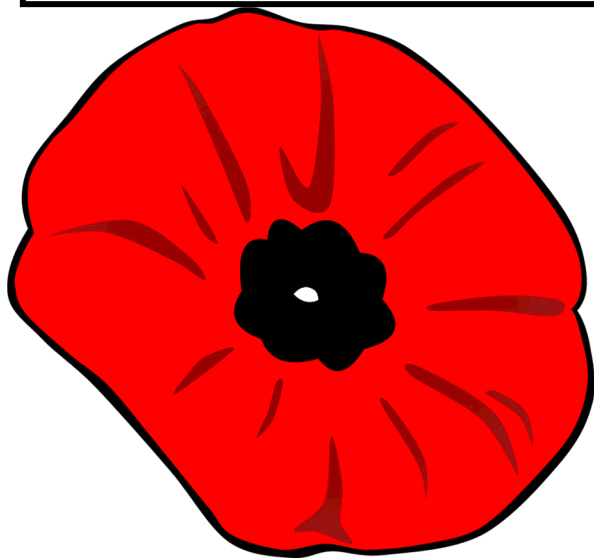

Veterans Legislation Roundup: This week the U.S. House unanimously passed more than a dozen pieces of legislation centered on veterans' care, including several VFW-supported bills, such as: H.R. 1900, the *National Veterans Memorial and Museum Act*, which would designate the Veterans Memorial and Museum in Columbus, Ohio, as the National Veterans Memorial and Museum; H.R. 3562, which tasks Specially Adapted Housing agents with providing adaptive housing assistance to veterans who use the independent living services as part of the Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment (VR&E) program; H.R. 3656, which would expand eligibility for memorial headstones and markers; H.R. 3657, which would expand burial benefits to eligible spouses and dependents interred in tribal veterans cemeteries; H.R. 2123, the *VETS Act of 2017*, which would authorize VA providers to practice telemedicine across state lines; H.R. 3705, the *Veterans Fair Debt Notice Act*, which would require VA to use certified mail and use plain language explanations when sending debt notices to veterans; and H.R. 3122, the *Veterans Care Financial Protection Act of 2017*, which would require VA to develop and implement standards that protect individuals who are eligible for this increased pension from dishonest, predatory or otherwise unlawful practices.

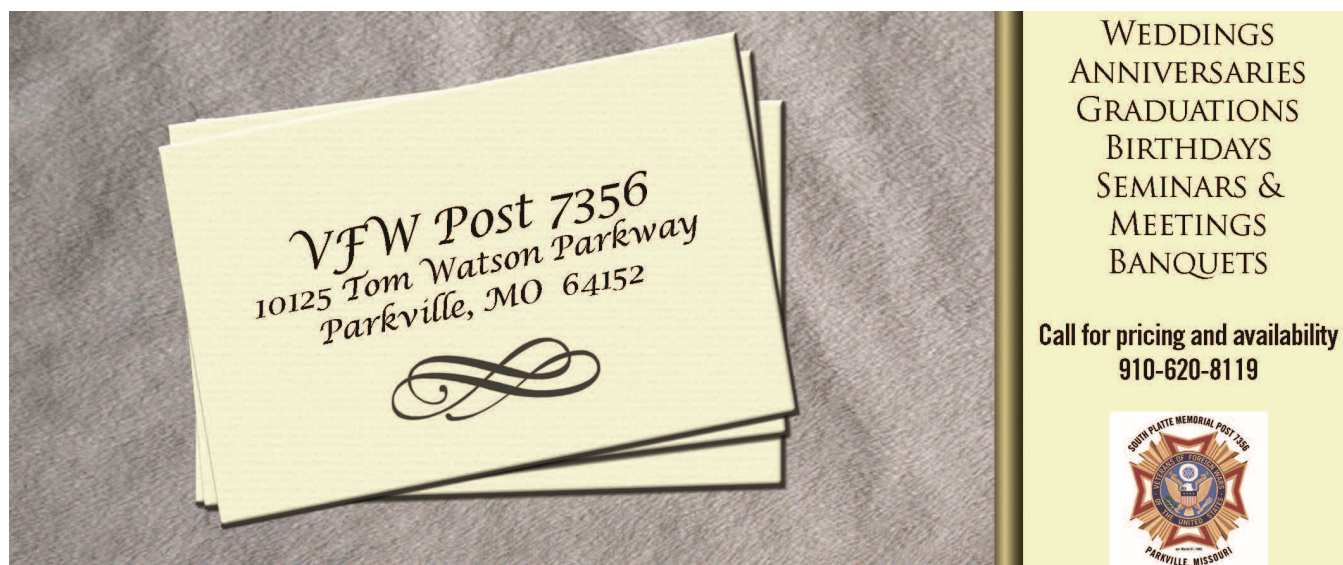
