A new project this year is to collect pop can tabs for the Ronald McDonald Houses. Their organization keeps families close to their sick children while they get the care and supportive services they need. On any given night the Houses here in Kansas City serves up to 87 families, providing comfort and care to families and friends of in-patients at Children's Mercy Hospital. Our pop tops they are weighed by the pound, with the aluminum sold and the money used to support the needs of the Houses. The Ronald McDonald Foundation is also very active in supporting research to find cures for many diseases that affect children. Save your pop tabs and bring to the post each time you are there. Collection containers will be behind the bar at the Post and downstairs in the CAP meeting area. Remember – when you pop a top, please pull the tab for Ronald! From the Hill

Blue Water Navy Veterans Closer to Receiving Benefits. With a unanimous 382-0 vote in the House on Monday, H.R. 299, the Blue Water Navy Vietnam Veterans Act of 2017, is closer than ever before to becoming law and finally providing Blue Water Navy veterans the benefits they have been denied for too long by VA's arbitrary and capricious regulations. The bill would also expand benefits to veterans exposed to Agent Orange while serving along the Korean DMZ and children born with spina bifida due to a parent's exposure during service in Thailand. It will also require VA to report on research being conducted on Gulf War Illness. The VFW calls on the Senate Committee on Veterans' Affairs to swiftly consider and pass this important legislation. Read the bill text

House Veterans' Affairs Subcommittee on Health held a hearing to review the large number of staffing shortages within VA. Currently there are approximately 38,000 vacancies, most of which are related to direct care for veterans.

House Armed Services Subcommittee on Military Personnel held a hearing to discuss recent changes in the Military Health System (MHS) to address the opioid epidemic. DHA Director Vice Adm. Raquel Bono informed the committee that the MHS has reduced opioid prescriptions by 15 percent and plans to expand non-pharmacologic therapies at military treatment facilities to reduce the reliance on high dose pain medication.

Awards

Army 1st Lt. Garlin Conner posthumously received the Medal of Honor in a White House ceremony, June 26, 2018 for his heroic actions during World War II. Conner is pictured below receiving a commendation after he risked his life against insurmountable odds on the morning of Jan 24, 1945.



POW/MIA Update:

The Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency has announced identification and burial updates for three American service members who had been missing in action from WWII. Returning home for burial with full military honors are:

Army Sgt. James K. Park was a member of Company I, 26th Infantry Regiment, 1st Infantry Division. On Nov. 23, 1944, Park was declared missing in action after being wounded while his unit was engaged in fierce fighting within the Hürtgen Forest in Germany

Navy Fireman 1st Class Walter F. Schleiter was stationed aboard the USS Oklahoma, which was moored at Ford Island, Pearl Harbor, when the ship was attacked by Japanese aircraft on Dec. 7, 1941.
