

Unaccompanied Minor Checklist



Passenger is 5-15 years old



- Unaccompanied minor service is **required**
- Accepted **only on nonstop flights** operated by United or United Express
- **Not accepted on connections** (to/from UA or other airline)
- Service charge is **\$150 for each flight**
- **Children under 5 years old are not permitted for this service**
- **Passengers age 16 and older do not qualify for unaccompanied minor service.** The youngest child's age determines acceptability of all children traveling together. For example, a 14 year-old traveling with a 17 year-old would still need unaccompanied minor service.

Document PNR for children and adults traveling together on separate reservations



To ensure that United identifies the child as accompanied, the following OSI must be added to the child's PNR: **OSI UA TCP WITH ADULT IN PNR** (adult's United record locator).

Call United to arrange and pay for UM service.



Customers should call United or agencies can call on their behalf and provide the following:

Credit card: Number, expiration date, CID, billing name and address

Drop-off and pick-up contacts: Name and address, phone number, relationship to child
