NACC Gallery Director Rachel M. Olszewski invites artists of all ages and backgrounds to participate in the NACC's 13th Annual *Beyond the Barrel Exhibit: NF125*, which celebrates the collective work of Niagara's astounding artists and craftsmen, proving that Niagara has so much more to offer than what initially comes to mind. Our NF125 exhibit is envisioned as an exposition of artworks that celebrate Niagara Falls beauty, history, renaissance, and civic pride. This exhibit will feature Judges **Michael Beam** of the Castellani Art Museum, **James Neiss**, celebrated photographer for the Niagara Gazette, & **Ally Spongr**, Special Projects Director for the Niagara Falls National Heritage Area. Artworks of all mediums and styles – two-dimensional and three-dimensional – are eligible for entry to this **juried show**. Prizes will be awarded for the following:

- o Award for Excellence in Sculpture \$100.00,
- o Award for Excellence in Painting \$100.00,
- o Award for Excellence in Mixed Media \$100.00,
- o The Barbara Maloney Tribute Award for Excellence in Photography, \$100.00.

Suggested Themes: Niagara Falls, History, #LiveNF, State Park, Niagara Renaissance, Culture, Wonder of the World, Daredevils, Escarpment, Local Plants & Wildlife, Suspension Bridge, Niagara Heroes, Olmsted, Art Park, Gorge, Tourism, Honeymoon Capital, Waterways, City in the Parks, Hyde Park, Architecture, Natural Wonder.

Beyond the Barrel: NF125 Exhibition opens on Friday, May 5^{th} , 2017 with an Artists' Reception from 5-7 p.m. Awards will be presented at 6:30 p.m. The Exhibition will close on Aug 6^{th} , 2017.

ENTRY GUIDELINES

(please read carefully)

- Deadline for entry is 5 p.m. on Monday, May 1, 2017. No applications will be accepted after this time and date. Submissions may be made in person at our Main Office or via email at info@thenacc.org (.jpgs and .pngs only) for this Juried Exhibition. Artists will be notified by May 1st if their Artwork has been accepted for this exhibit.
- After notification of acceptance, artwork must be delivered with Entry Fee payment at the 2nd Floor NACC Main Office starting Feb 1st, 2017 May 1st 2017.
 - ✓ Entry fee is \$30 for the first two pieces and \$10 for up to two (2) additional pieces.
 - ✓ Four (4) piece maximum.
 - ✓ Drop off appointments outside of that time may be arranged by calling 282-7530.
- Entry fees can also be made by check or money order made payable to Niagara Arts and Community Center and mailed to: NACC, 1201 Pine Avenue, Niagara Falls, NY 14301
- Selected artists must submit a brief Artist's Statement Entry Form describing your career as an artist and providing insight into your works.
- Submitted artwork must be for sale. "Price on Request" or "Not for Sale" pieces will not be accepted. .
- Entries must be priced for sale that includes a 25% NACC commission.
- All entries must include a label on the back or underside that includes the following information: NAME OF
 ARTIST, TITLE OF WORK, ARTISTIC MEDIUM and PRICE. Artwork WILL NOT be accepted
 without proper labeling.
- All entries must be ready for hanging / installation. NACC will not accept entries that have not been prepared for hanging or for standalone display. Two-dimensional works must be <u>framed and wired</u> for installation. Three-dimensional works must have a non-abrasive base or be mounted on a pedestal.
- No art will be used or redistributed for any other reason without express permission from the Artist. If you would like your artwork to be used in Marketing Materials, please let us know upon submission!

DROP OFF & PICK UP PROCEDURES

- Artwork must be delivered before May 1st, 2017, with payment at the office on NACC Main Office on the 2nd floor, or mailed with check or money order made payable to Niagara Arts and Community Center to: NACC, 1201 Pine Avenue, Niagara Falls, NY 14301.
- Artwork will not be included in the exhibition if payment is not received.
- Artwork MUST be picked up from the NACC between Aug 6 and Aug 14th 2017 during NACC hours. The NACC is not responsible for any artwork left at the NACC after 5 p.m. on Aug 14th, 2017. Artwork will not be released for any reason before Aug 6th.





Gallery Policy:

The NACC Gallery Committee reserves the right to refuse artworks that do not follow exhibition guidelines, including but not limited to artworks that do not pertain to the exhibition theme and requirements or have been found unbefitting of the intent of the exhibition.

Non Discrimination Policy:
