Call for Proposals

We are looking for innovative, compelling and inspirational presentations to expand the field of infant and toddler early care and learning.

Topical Area:

Child and family well-being is enhanced when each are empowered to achieve their greatest potential. Conference topics should prompt interaction on all the possibilities for young children: play, exploration, developing secure & nurturing relationships, technology and young children, importance of attachment, caregiver support, and other topics related to infant/toddler growth and care. Content should be reflective of NAEYC Developmentally Appropriate Practice Guidelines.

Proposal Deadline: **December 1, 2016.**

Format: Session presentations will be 1.5 hours in length and will be interactive workshops.

Provisions for Selected Presenters:

- 1 complimentary conference registration and meals as provided with the conference registration. Guests of the presenter may register for the conference at a discounted (pre-registration) fee.
- Session evaluation summary.
- A complimentary shuttle is available from the airport to the hotel, provided by the Downtown Doubletree Hotel.
- Podium and lapel microphone.
- LCD projector with VGA connection cables and screen will be provided. Presenters must provide their own connection cables if VGA cables cannot be used with their computer or tablet. Wireless projector connection will not be available. Presenters must supply all other necessary accessories for their presentations.
- Breakout rooms will be set up with round tables and chairs or in classroom style with tables and chairs.

Presenter's Responsibilities:

- Presenters are expected to pay all travel, hotel accommodations, incidentals, per diem expenses and special event fees for themselves and their guests.
- Presenters MUST provide their own computer, tablet, etc. with their presentation pre-loaded on the device or on a flash drive. All video presentations are the responsibility of the presenters.
- All handouts for sessions are the responsibility of the selected presenter.
