Students from the Young Adult Program and of Independence Hall at Chelsea High School, along with their artist mentors will be onsite to talk about the project process. The Wasthenaw ISD Young Adult Program will host an open house in their classrooms located in the lower level of the Sylvan building, which is located next to the Mack building.
