



Thank you for your interest in getting involved with the Soup Sisters & Brothers organization. Our success depends on a good team of volunteers and a willing and generous group of soup makers. Here's how we explain the difference between a participant (soup maker) and an event volunteer, as it is not always clear how we work together to offer the gift of soup to the shelters we support.

***Participant (Soup Maker)*** This is the person who pays the participation fee to attend the event and actually makes the soup that is delivered fresh to the recipient shelter. The participant fee covers the cost of all soup ingredients, kitchen rental & staff, a meal and wine at the event.

***Event Volunteer*** - Each event requires a number of volunteers that help the events run smoothly before, during and after the events. Duties may include helping to tray the ingredients for each soup station, setting up the soup stations, setting the dining table, manning the registration table, serving the dinner, cleaning up and tearing down the room.
