- Watch for our Welcome Weeks events in our August newsletter. Pass our Welcome Weeks invite on to your student and encourage them to come check out Wesley!

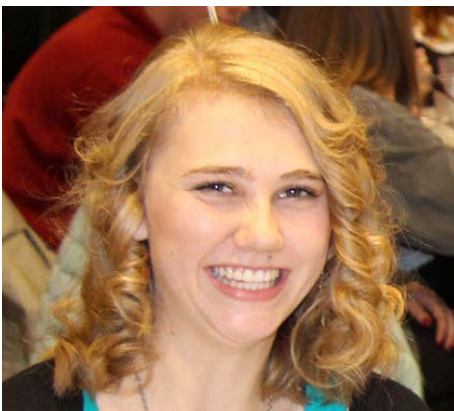
