Purpose of Committee Conference on the Presiding Member’s Proposed Decision

The purpose of the Committee Conference is to consider oral and written comments on the PMPD from the parties, governmental agencies, and members of the public.

Oral comments may be submitted by the public during the Committee Conference.

Following the end of the 30-day public comment period, the Committee, if appropriate, may prepare Errata to the PMPD describing changes to the PMPD recommended by the Committee after its consideration of comments from the parties and the public.

e-Filing and e-Commenting

Comment Deadline

The deadline for filing comments on the PMPD is March 15, 2017. In order to assure that your comments are considered, they must be electronically uploaded to the e-filing system, or your e-mail received by the Docket Unit or your mailed written comment physically delivered by March 15, 2017.

Persons making comments, especially the parties, are encouraged to share their comments in writing, prior to the Committee Conference. It is helpful to see significant comments, especially those proposing changes to the Conditions of Certification, prior to the Conference so that the Committee and parties can discuss and understand the proposals and attempt to resolve any conflicts or inconsistencies. To facilitate those discussions, the parties are requested to submit their comments on or before **Thursday, February 23, 2017.**

Public Adviser and Public Participation

Members of the public are welcome to offer comments at the committee conference. It is not necessary to be an intervenor to participate in the public process.
