1. We Believe Prayer is Plan A (Dependence on God)

Matthew 14:22-23

²² Immediately Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead of him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowd. ²³ After he had dismissed them, he went up on a mountainside by himself to pray.

2. We Use the Bible as Our Map (Biblical Authority)

2 Timothy 3:16-17

“All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.”

3. We Always Point People to Jesus (Relational Evangelism)

Matthew 4:19

“Come, follow me,” Jesus said, “and I will send you out to fish for people.”

4. We Lead and We Follow (Discipleship and Mentoring)

Hebrews 10:24-25

²⁴ And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, ²⁵ not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

5. We All Have a Part to Play (Faithful Service)

1 Corinthians 12:27

²⁷ Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it.

6. We Share (Outrageous Generosity)

2 Corinthians 9:6-7

“Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.”
