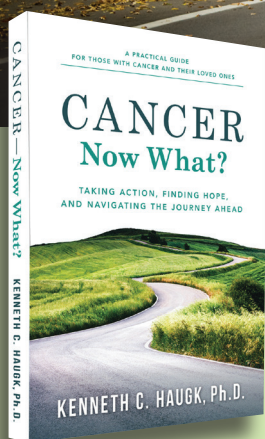

KENNETH C. HAUGK, PH.D.

Kenneth C. Haugk is a psychologist, author, pastor, and teacher. He received his Ph.D. in clinical psychology from Washington University and his M.Div. from Concordia Seminary, both in St. Louis, Missouri. In 2003, he received an honorary Doctor of Laws degree from Concordia University Chicago.

Dr. Haugk is the founder and executive director of Stephen Ministries, which is best known for the Stephen Series system of lay caregiving. Over 70,000 people have attended week-long training conferences to lead Stephen Ministry in their churches and other organizations, and they in turn have trained over 600,000 laypeople to provide high-quality, one-to-one care for those who are going through difficult times in life.

Dr. Haugk is the author of 16 books. He is a frequent conference and workshop speaker and has been published widely in psychological journals and popular periodicals on a variety of topics, including community mental health, pastoral counseling, lay caregiving, conflict resolution, and leadership.
