

### HIMALAYAN MINISTRY

This ministry works with Himalayan Good News Ministry, International Victory Prayer Tower Ministry, Atmik Jivan Ministries and Bhutan Prayer and Revival Church to spread the gospel in India, Nepal, Bhutan, and the Solukhumbu District of Nepal in the Mt. Everest region. This remote Himalayan district was greatly affected by the earthquake in 2015. Christian literature is not widespread in these regions. The few churches in the countryside of Bhutan are underground and open evangelism is illegal; therefore, very little mission work is being done in this area. The Christian population in India is just over 2%, Nepal less than 2% and Bhutan is less than 1%.

The primary focus right now is in the villages of the Himalayas. These people mostly live off the land without any transportation or electricity. They have no church buildings and the education for the children is not good.

### VILLAGE OF HOPE - UGANDA

Village of Hope Uganda has built and operates two villages which provide food, shelter, education, medical attention, trauma counseling and vocational training for double orphans who are victims of a long civil war and HIV/AIDS. God has brought together a diverse group of churches and people in order to bring hope and healing to as many as 600 orphans. Another at-risk group of people served by Village of Hope Uganda are "child mothers". These women were abducted by a rebel army as children and forced to serve as "bush wives" to rebels. Many became pregnant and after escaping or being rescued were looked upon as being "defiled" and stigmatized which puts them at severe risk of being impoverished and marginalized. Village of Hope operates the Tabitha Project to train these women in trades and crafts that they can use to earn a living for their families. The goals of Village of Hope are to raise up a generation of godly men and women in Northern Uganda who will be leaders and productive citizens, bring to Christ and disciple as many as possible, and to have a positive impact on the communities in which the villages are located.
