What is UGive?

UGive.org bridges the gap between schools encouraging community service, charities desperately in need of volunteers, and the students who have the time, energy and passion to do the work. Students can search the UGive website, calendar, and map for volunteer activities that match their interest, schedules, and locations. UGive then tracks the students' confirmed hours.

[UGIVE.ORG](https://ugive.org) is a non-profit organization on a mission to catalyze, excite and empower the next generation of volunteers.

UGive makes philanthropy relevant to students, guiding them to give their time and talents to build communities. Our goal is to create LIFE-LONG GIVERS!

On Nov. 1st, you received an email from info@ugive.org, asking you to log on with a temporary password. **Please do so.** After logging in, you will see your name and **Indian Hill** in the upper right-hand corner. Click on your name to **change your password.** Any problems, including forgotten passwords, or questions, please email info@ugive.org

Your account will be tied to Indian Hill and will provide:

- FREE access to volunteer opportunities for ALL types of causes that meet your own interests and schedules - all UGIVE posted opportunities are with 501(c)3 nonprofits or schools
- FREE online verified service resume to use for school requirements and college apps
- Opportunity to earn National Jefferson Awards and "Hall of Fame" school status
- Priceless opportunity to connect with like-minded students to serve and change the world!

Sign up for the opportunity you are interested in by clicking on **Sign Up**. Some opportunities require you to call or email the charity to set up a date and time. You can let your friends know about opportunities you are interested in or have signed up for by clicking on Share This.

How are volunteer hours confirmed?

You can get confirmed one of two ways. After completing the volunteer opportunity, the charity will need to go back to UGIVE.ORG and confirm your attendance. Once this is done your hours will automatically show up in your profile. If this does not happen you should contact the charity to request they complete this step, and if you need assistance getting this done, you can contact UGIVE.ORG.

How do I know how many hours have been recorded?

Students can login to UGive and look at their **service resume** under their profile.

How can I add hours to my service resume if I volunteered for an opportunity that was not listed on the website?

Mrs. Mendoza in the HS Media Center can enter external volunteer hours so they show up on your service resume. Make sure you complete the [Outside Community Service Verification Evaluation Form](#) from the non-profit organization. Once all documentation is submitted your hours will be entered and will appear in your service resume.

What are Qualified vs. Regular hours?

Regular hours are **red**- volunteering in our school community (five hours max./year)
Qualified hours are **white**- volunteering at a non-profit (no maximum).
