

Item #	Descriptions of Flowers Offered	(see order form)
01 Allium Caeruleum - Fragrant variety with 1-2" blue blooms resulting in a sphere. Great for pollinators! Deer & rodent resistant. Full to half sun. Blooms early summer. Ht.: 14-16" HZ: 2-10		
02 Drumstick Allium – Easy to grow variety with egg shaped, cranberry colored flowering heads. Makes great cut or dried flowers! Deer & rodent resistant. Full to half sun. Blooms early summer. Ht.: 20-24" HZ: 2-10		
03 Large Flowering Crocus Mix - Use in borders; group together for naturalizing. Assortment of purples, whites and yellows. Great for pollinators! Full to partial sun. Blooms in early spring. Ht.: 4-6" HZ: 3-9		
04 Carnegie Hyacinth – A creamy white dense spike of fragrant florets surrounded by green sword-like foliage. Great for walkways! Prefers well-drained soil in full sun/partial shade. Blooms mid spring. Ht.: 10-12" HZ: 2-10		
05 Blue Jacket Hyacinth Rated as the #1 variety of Hyacinths with its stunningly vibrant blue petals. Full to partial sun. Blooms mid spring. Ht.: 10-12" HZ: 2-10		
06 Sapphire Beauty Dutch Iris – Upright stems support a delicate array of sapphire blue petals with yellow centers. A great cut flower! For best results, layer with mulch for winter. Full sun. Blooms early summer. Ht.: 20-24" HZ: 5-10		
07 Dwarf Iris Mix – Low height mix of purples, pale and deep blues, and yellow. Plant 4" deep and 4" apart for best results. Deer & rodent resistant. Full sun. Blooms in early April. Ht.: 4-6" HZ: 2-10		
08 Winter Buttercup – Minimal green foliage with dainty yellow flowers. Prefers rich, moist humus soil and part shade. Blooms early spring. Ht.: 3-4" HZ: 5-8		
09 Peppermint Grape Hyacinth – Also known as “delft blue mixed muscari. Deep cobalt, periwinkle, and light airy blues, the colors in this mix will not disappoint! Will naturalize and multiply. Full to partial sun. Blooms mid spring. Ht.: 4-8" HZ: 3-9		
10 Giant Snowdrops - Reminiscent of Lily of the Valley but flowers are more visible, these dainty white flowers resemble clusters of small white bells hanging from their stems. Deer & rodent resistant. Blooms in late spring. Ht.: 14-16" HZ: 4-10		
11 Pipit Narcissus – Vivid yellow petals surround a white trumpet. A dainty looking flower. Deer resistant. A nice companion to the Jack Snipe Narcissus. Full to partial sun. Blooms mid spring. Ht.: 12-14" HZ: 2-10		
12 Peach Swirl Narcissus – White double petals surround the brilliant orange and white double trumpet center. Fragrant, makes for a great cut flower. Deer resistant. Prefers full to partial sun. Blooms mid spring. Ht.: 14-16" HZ: 2-10		
13 Dutch Master Daffodil - Most popular of all large, yellow daffodils. Excellent for large landscaping jobs. Great for pollinators! Fragrant. Deer & rodent resistant. Full to partial sun. Blooms in April. Ht.: 14-16" HZ: 2-10		
14 Narcissus Jack Snipe - A cyclamineus narcissus that produces cute blooms of white petals and vivid yellow cups. Ideal for cluster planting and rock gardens; will naturalize. Resist deer and squirrel. Plant 6" deep and 6" apart. Full to partial sun. Blooms in April. Ht.: 8-10" HZ: 2-10		
15 Cheerfulness Double Flowering Narcissus – White petals with a partial white/partial yellowy-orange center. Double petals and a double trumpet make for an appealing addition to your garden! Full to partial sun, blooms mid spring. Ht.: 14-16" HZ: 2-10		
16 Apricot Foxx Triumph Tulip – A gorgeous flower with shades of oranges, almost resembling a peach. Great cut flower. Full to partial sun. Blooms mid spring. Ht.: 18-20" HZ: 2-8		

17 Purple Peony Double Late Tulip – A beautiful variety with a double bloom giving it the look of petit peony. Vibrant purple petals. Full to partial sun. Blooms late spring. Ht.: 16-18" HZ: 2-8

18 Rosalie Triumph Tulip – Pale pink petals, offering a dainty and feminine look to any garden. Full to partial shade. Blooms mid spring. Ht.: 18-20" HZ: 2-8

19 Nightrider Tulip – An exciting variety with green petals with vibrant magenta edges. Full sun to partial shade. Blooms late spring. Ht.: 18-20" HZ: 2-8

20 Apricot Impression Darwin Hybrid Tulip – Sword-like foliage on a sturdy stem supports a vibrant orange/pink flower head. A wonderful cut flower. Full to partial sun. Blooms mid spring. Ht.: 20-22" HZ: 2-8

21 Hakuun Darwin Hybrid Tulip – A wonderful white tulip. Very easy to grow. Blooms mid spring. Ht.: 20-24" HZ: 2-8

22 Little Beauty Specialty Tulip – Unique pink pointed petals make way for a white and blue center. Full sun will bring out their color though partial shade will give for longer bloom time. Bloom late spring Ht.: 4-6" HZ: 2-10

23 Fashion Kaufmanniana Tulip – A small tulip with rose red petals with a white edge. When completely open shows a lovely yellow center. Full to partial sun. Blooms mid spring. Ht.: 5-6" HZ: 2-8

24 Lebanon Squill – Delicate white petals with blue veins. Great at naturalizing. Full to partial sun. Blooms early spring. Ht.: 4-6" HZ: 3-10

25 Softneck Garlic – a mild flavored, all-purpose garlic. Great for braiding. Stores well for 6-9 months. Full sun. Harvest in summer. HZ: 3-9

Bulb Fertilizer – A mild organic fertilizer. A 3.5 lb. bag will cover 87.5 square feet. "9-9-6" variety
