Know Your PFAFF—Owner's Class One—Sewing Machine Basics—Learn how to thread your machine, wind a bobbin, change stitches and sew much more

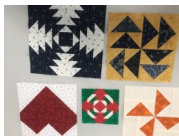
Thursday, September 6—4-7 pm

Introduction to Paper Piecing—

Join us for a class to learn the basics of foundation paper piecing, or perhaps it will be a good refresher if you haven't worked with foundation paper piecing in a while. We will help you get comfortable with this technique by working on a few examples in class. You will get tips and ideas for using foundation paper piecing on quilts and other projects.

It's A Mystery! - Are you ready for a little quilting adventure? We have a 4-part class to create a delightful quilt. The finished quilt will be 51" x 68", or 58" x 75" if adding an optional border.

The parts for this quilt will be created in each of the first 3 sessions. In the 4th class, the parts will be assembled to complete the quilt top and the mystery will be revealed.

You will need just 3 fabrics. Choose fabrics which you like. This quilt pattern will look wonderful in so many different fabric combinations. Select fabrics which provide a good contrast between your background fabric and with each other as this will show off the pattern. For best results, avoid directional fabrics and large prints.

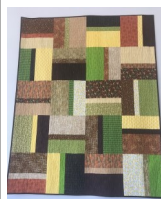
Open Sewing—This is a day set aside for you to leave the housework, and dishes behind and spend the day sewing with friends. A perfect time to start your Christmas sewing.
