Machine embroidery gives the bags beautiful quilting and precise placement of the welt pocket then the bags are finished using regular sewing techniques. We will be completing the medium size bag in class.




Premier+ Ultra—You can embroider designs that are too large for your machine's hoops. Learn how to split designs so you can embroider large designs a section at a time with whatever hoop or machine you have. Whether creating the focal point in the center of a quilt, or embroidering the back of a jacket, you don't have to be limited by your machine's hoop size.

Saturday, May 6—9:30-12:00 Noon

A Day At The Zoo—Spend the day at the zoo with 16 unique wild animals! Join us to make this darling twin size quilt, baby quilt or wall hanging. Animals are all created using embroidery applique. Blocks and borders are all sewn. Get creative with your backgrounds and borders! And not to worry—most designs will fit in the 240 x 150 hoop. Those that don't use the 360 x 200 hoop or are done with 2 hoopings. The design we will use is "A Day at the Zoo" by Smith Street Designs (available at JSS). There is an applique kit is available for all of the animals—that is what I used (pre-order from is required).

Summer in the Park Quilt—This fresh bright quilt is another creation by Jenny Doan of MSQC. This quilt is made by sewing strips of fabric into a tube and then cut into blocks which are used to form this unique quilt. The pattern makes a quilt 74" x 81".

Pickle Blooms Table Runner—Use the Pickle Blooms pattern to make a fun summer table runner. This is a quilt-as-you-go project incorporating fun, time saving techniques that include making your own bias tape, fusible



applique using the decorative stitches on your machine, and folded edge applique using no-melt mylar template plastic. The pattern also includes directions to make matching place mats to complete your summer table.


