## Proposition HHH Facilities Program FY 2017-18 Request for Proposals Released for the FY 2018-19 Bond Issuance

The Proposition HHH (Prop HHH) Facilities Program Fiscal Year (FY) 2017-18 Request for Proposals (RFP) for the FY 2018-19 Bond Issuance was released today, Friday, August 25, 2017, on the Los Angeles Business Assistance Virtual Network (LABAVN). The full RFP, including all attachments and frequently asked questions, may be downloaded directly from the LABAVN website at <a href="https://labavn.org/">https://labavn.org/</a>.

The proposal period will remain open through Friday, November 3, 2017. Proposers Conferences will be held on Thursday, September 7, 2017 and Wednesday, October 4, 2017.

The Prop HHH Facilities Program RFP will award funds for the acquisition and/or improvement of real property for facilities that provide services or goods to, or otherwise benefit, persons experiencing homelessness or chronic homelessness, or who are at risk of homelessness. Funding is available for brick-and-mortar construction expenses only; funding is not available for operational expenses or services. The RFP is open to proposals from non-profit entities, private entities, or other public entities that provide services on behalf of and within the boundaries of the City. Partnerships between service providers, developers, and other organizations are encouraged.

This is the second Prop HHH Facilities Program RFP released by the City of Los Angeles since the approval of Prop HHH in November 2016. The first Prop HHH Facilities Program RFP was an expedited process, which resulted in a bond issuance of over \$12 million awarded to six (6) projects including medical clinics, transitional housing and service centers. An additional \$73 million was issued for nine (9) Permanent Supportive Housing projects, which will produce 615 total affordable units. 416 of these units will be supportive housing units. The City's Housing and Community Investment Department will release its Call for Projects for the Prop HHH Permanent Supportive Housing Loan Program in October.
