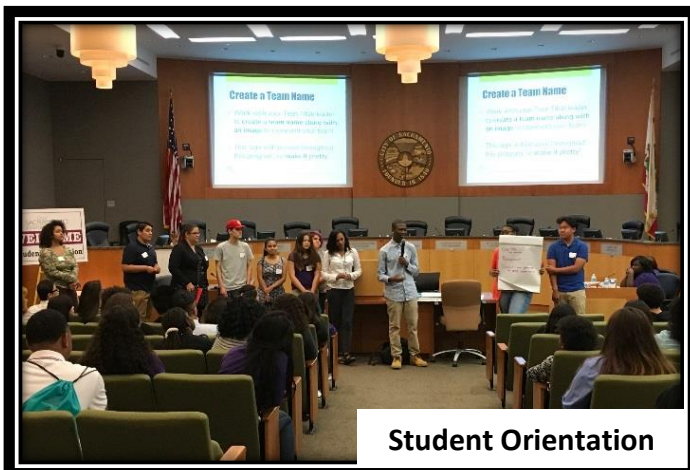


2018 Student Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) Sheet

Important Information

- Summer @ City Hall (S@CH) is a six-week summer program taught by certified high school teachers with an emphasis on teaching civic engagement and youth development through interactive and small group classes. Classroom sessions are weekly Monday through Thursday 8:30 AM – 12:00 PM with Friday Life Skills Workshops 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM at New City Hall, 915 I Street.
- Selected students are required to attend two **mandatory** sessions including the *Student & Parent/Guardian Orientation* scheduled for Saturday, June 2nd 1:30 PM – 4:30 PM plus the first in the series of *Life Skills Workshops: Being Prepared for a Job* scheduled for Friday, June 15th 2:00 – 5:00 PM. Instructional class sessions begin Monday, June 18th with an ending date of Thursday, July 26th.
- During the S@CH program, a student must complete the instructional classroom sessions **AND** a 42-hour internship to receive the stipend and five high school credits*. (**The stipend and high school elective credits will be available to students attending an eligible SCUSD, TRUSD or NUSD high school. Students who do not attend any these school districts but live within the Sacramento city limits are considered At-Large students and will receive the stipend only.*)
- Internships begin Monday, June 25th and conclude Thursday, July 26th. Internship locations and schedules will vary depending on internship assignment and will not be more than nine hours per week (3 hours/day, 3 days/week).
- **FREE** breakfast is available at 8:00 AM to all students along with **FREE** lunch service at 12:00 PM each day (both are optional but highly encouraged).
- All students will be provided a **FREE** Regional Transit Connect Card pass during the S@CH summer program which allows for access to the public transit system.
