Do you currently have Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)? Does your DACA expire between September 5, 2017 and March 5, 2018? If so, you MUST renew your DACA by October 5, 2017 if you plan to renew.

If you need assistance completing your DACA application and associated forms, or need legal advice related to renewing your DACA, please come to our free DACA renewal clinic. Attorneys will be available to assist you in preparing your DACA renewal. Labor and employment attorneys will also be available for questions.

Who may attend: This event is for current DACA recipients with a work permit under DACA that expires between September 5, 2017 and March 5, 2018.

Cost: Free!

What to bring: Copy of previous DACA application if available, copy of the front and back of your work permit, copy of your social security card, 2 passport style photos, the \$495 filing fee in the form of a money order or cashier's check made out to U.S. Department of Homeland Security (no abbreviations).
