

HAUTE CREATE

The Main Library features Haute Create, a classroom space with a 75-inch Samsung SmartTV that offers computer and software instruction for up to 12 people. Classes include printing pancakes with the PancakeBot food printer, creating wearable technology using the Singer Curvy sewing machines and LED circuits, and learning how to create sculptures, replacement parts and toys with the 3D printers.
