This is about the community taking care of its young people.

In Minnesota there are over 6,000 youth ages 16-24 experiencing homelessness on any given night. Youth-specific shelter beds in Minnesota are limited, leaving the vast majority of youth without stable housing. Shelters are expensive to build and costly to operate. As a community, we need to think creatively about how we can provide resources to our youth.

The Minneapolis and Suburban Host Home Program is an “outside the system” community and volunteer-based response to youth homelessness. Volunteers open their homes to young people looking for living stability, basic needs support, and healthy connections. Avenues’ staff support youth and hosts in the program.
