## PUTTING THE BRAKES ON HUMAN TRAFFICKING

### Transportation's Role in the Fight

In November 2012, the Transportation Leaders Against Human Trafficking partnership was launched. The partnership is an open membership group comprised of transportation and travel industry stakeholders, in order to maximize the transportation industry's collective impact in combating human trafficking. In November, 2013 Dallas Area Rapid Transit became one of only four transit agencies in the country to sign that pledge. As a result, DART has become an industry leader in addressing and combating human trafficking. This discussion gives listeners a better understanding of the human trafficking epidemic, how it affects their communities, and what the transportation industry can do to help eradicate modern day slavery.
