FBC Yard Sale

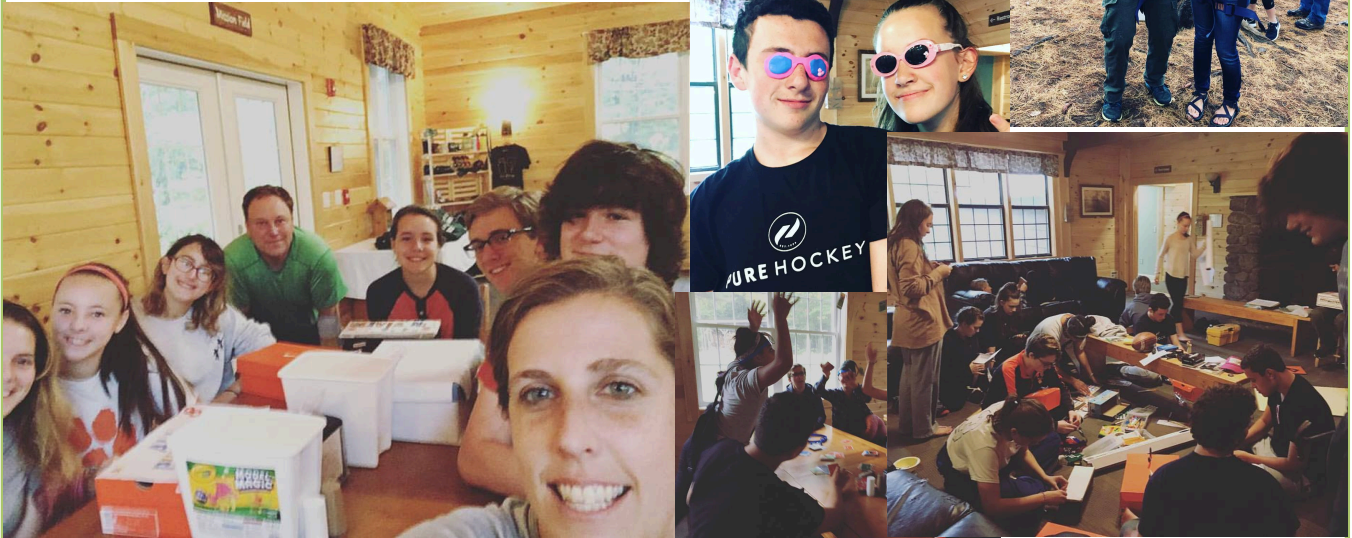
October 28 from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Nicaragua Needs Our Help!

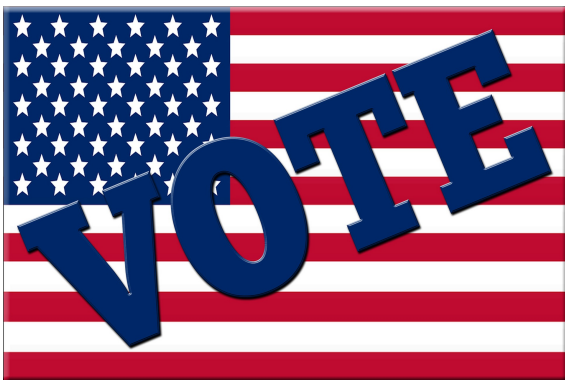
