

The museum's education program wrapped its 27th season at the end of May. 1475 students from 20 Maui and interisland schools traveled to the Sugar Museum to learn about what life was like on the plantation in the early 1900s, as well as the process of sugar from field to factory. Students also enjoyed hands on activities and a docent led tour of the museum as part of the experience.
